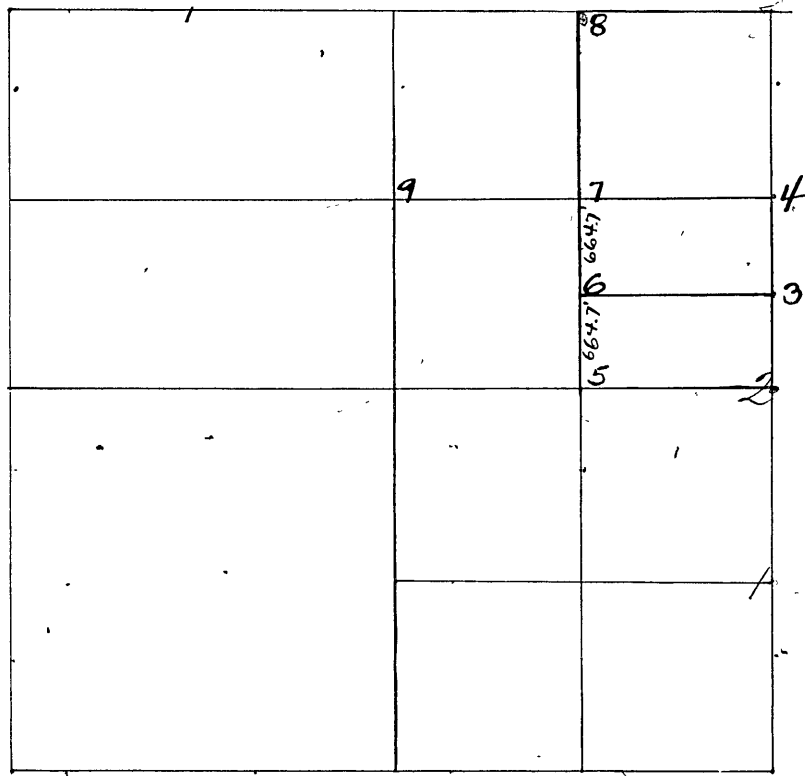


SECTION Twenty two (22), TOWNSHIP Eleven (11)

Surveyed by John Sharp Surveyor Clay County February 24th 1857 and corners set from 15^o E.



Corner No. 1 Poplar 30 in S 20 1/2 W 47 links
 " " 2 W. Oak 30 in - 21 1/2 W 34 links

Further surveyed by Fred C. Wilson, Dep. Sur. of Clay Co, April 10 + 11, 1911. Ten days notice was given all interested parties. The following corners were set:-

- Cor # 2 (reset) S.S. m x 8" x 12" x 28" Wit. S.S. 22" Long - West 15 Ft.
- Cor # 3 S.S. m x 8" x 8" x 21" Wit. S.S. 8" x 8" x 18" West 15"
- Cor # 4 S.S. m x 18" Long Wit. S.S. 14" Long West 15"
- Cor # 5 S.S. m x 7" x 8" x 22" Wit. S.S. 21" " South 92 Ft.
- Cor # 6 S.S. m x 7" x 8" x 33" " 664.7 ft. South of # 7
- Cor # 8 S.S. m x 10" x 14" Wit. S.S. 15" Long South 40 Ft
- Cor # 9 S.S. m x 8" x 8" x 26" Wit. S.S. 20" " " 10 Ft. ^{Jan 1-1911}
- Cor # 7 S.S. m x 7" x 8" x 24" " S.S. 18" Long " 10"
