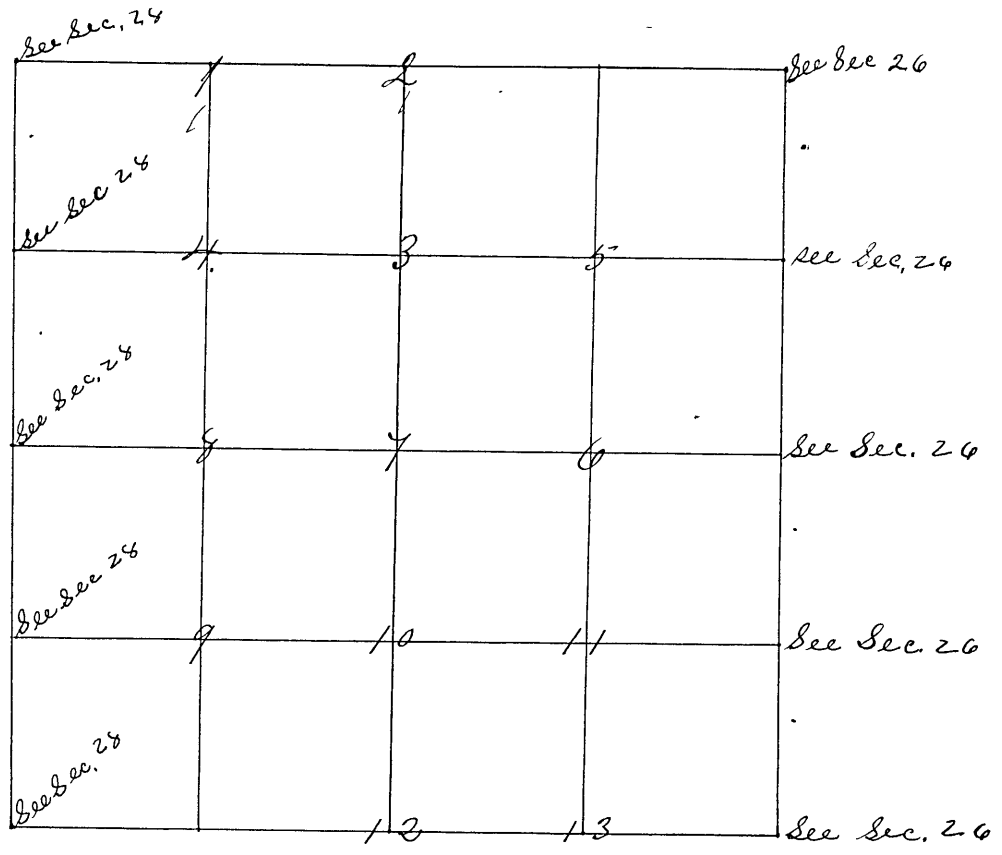


SECTION Twenty Seven (27) TOWNSHIP Eleven (11)
