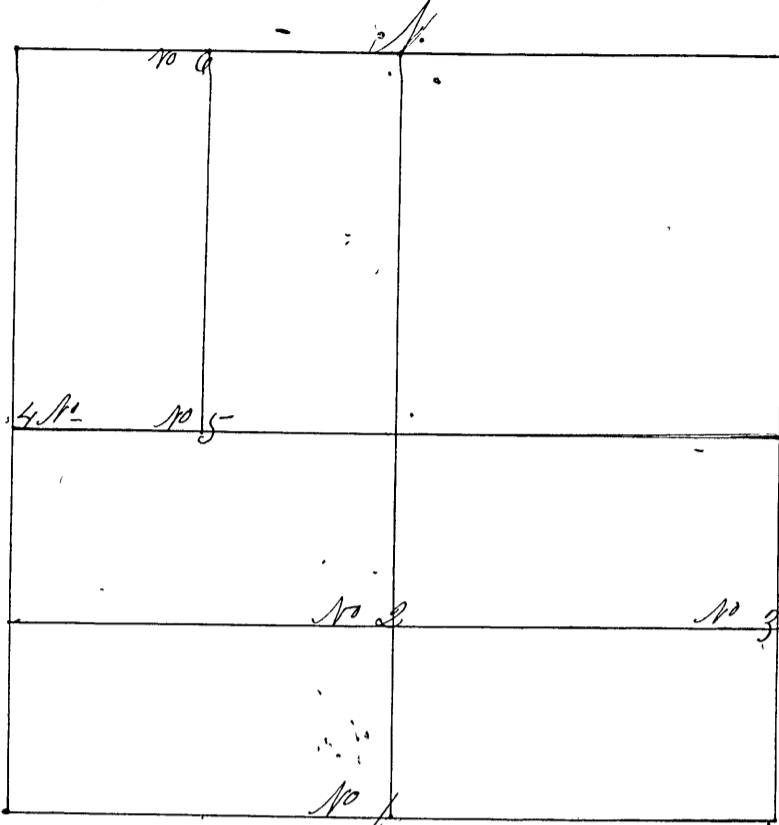


Surveyed by J. J. Peyton Surveyor of Clay County, Feb^r. the 21 to 24th 1854 and corners set from 1 to 6.
