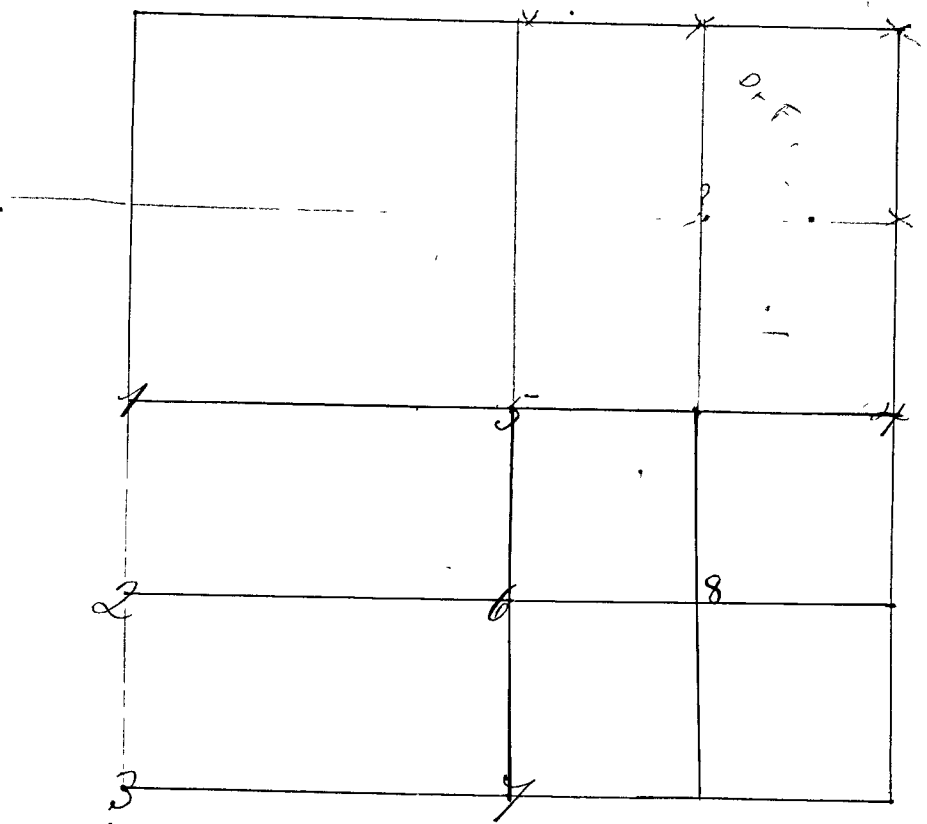


SECTION Thirty six (36), TOWNSHIP Thirteen (13)

Surveyed by John H. Davis County Survey May 7th 1859  
agreeable to notice published in the "Clay county Weekly  
Democrat" April 14th 1859 vol. 2 No. 19 3 weeks  
Robert Moore & Amos Yocum sworn as chain-  
bearers. Charles Clark flag carrier & James Phillips at man  
corners were set from No. 1 to 7 Bearings taken at same location the lines
