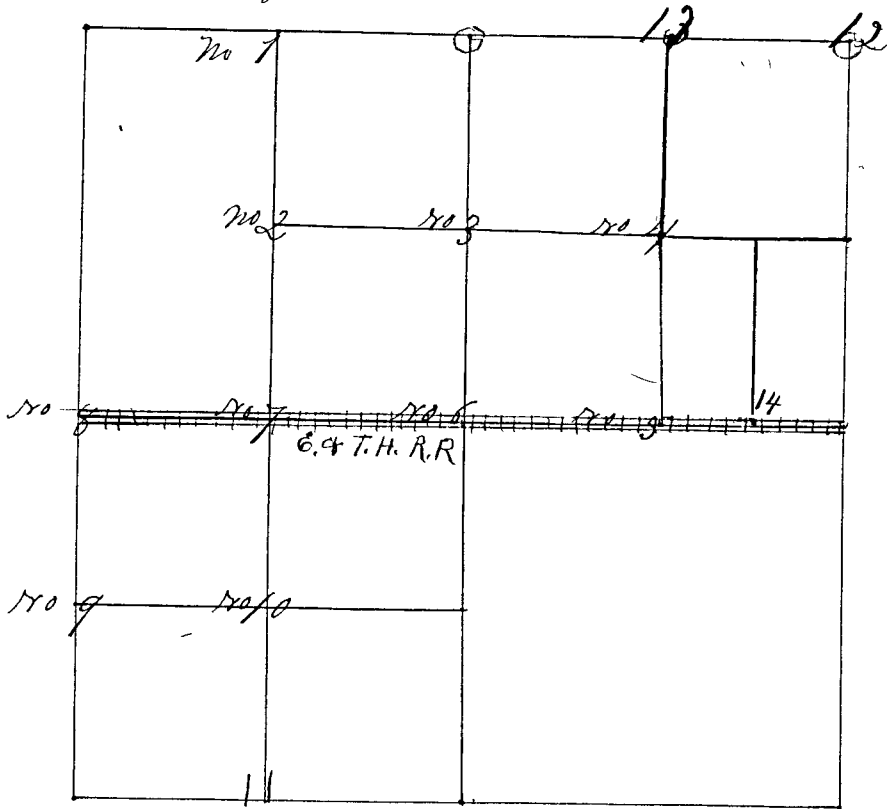


SECTION *Twinsten* (19), TOWNSHIP *Clewin* (11)
