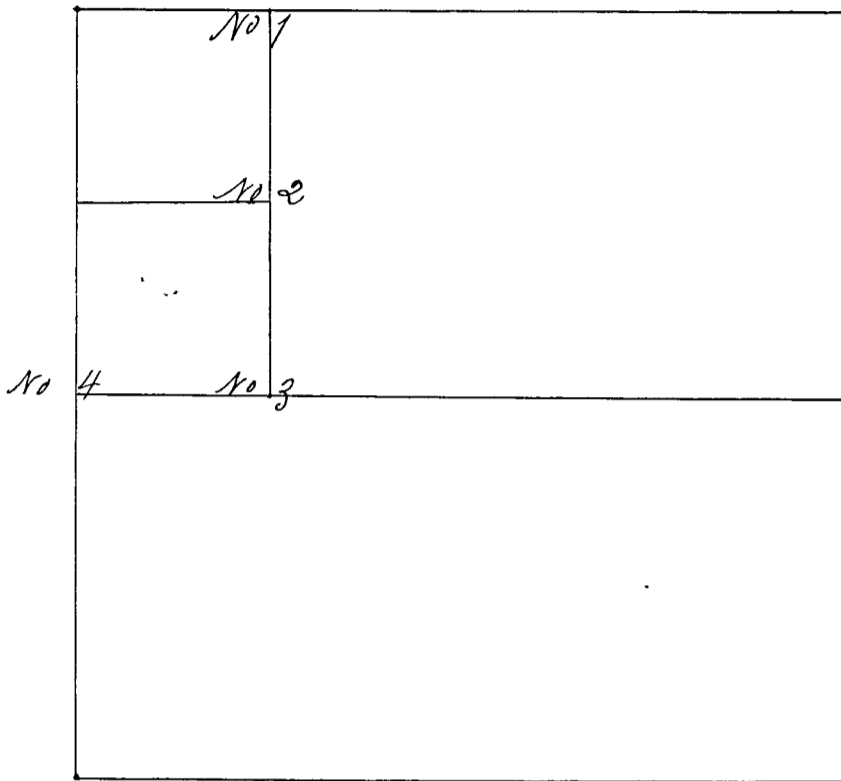


SECTION *Twenty eight, 28,* TOWNSHIP *Emble (12)*

Mutual consent and parties present James Coak & *Modeste*
chain carriers James Coak. *Marker* sworn according to Law, and
corners set at variation of lines about 5 deg W. from one to four inclusive



- Corner No 1 a Stone 13 in N line W 1/4 m corner
 " " " White Oak 24 in N 9 3/4 W 6 5/2 links
 " " " White Oak 36 N 4 3/4 E 119 links
- Corner No 2 a Blue Stone 24 in center N W q.
- " " " Burr Oak 6 north 26 7/8 links
 " " " Maple 6 N 84 E 32 links
- Corner No 3 a Boulder Stone 16 in E & W, center line met 1/4 mile corner
 " " " White Oak 16 N 52 1/2 W 57 3/4 links
 " " " White Oak 30 N 77 1/2 E 30 links
- Corner No 4 a Stone 13 (48) West 1/2 m corner, Original trees cut
 down and stumps part, dead.
 Hickory 24 N 48 1/2 E 77 links
 Red Oak 24 S 36 1/4 W 98 links
