Corner No. 9. a Stone in the center of the "Nation's Road" on the line between sections 35 & 36 T13 N of R 7 W, "14 Poles & 19 Links" North of the South West corner of said Section 36 & S. E. corner of 35.

Further surveyed by Homer Hicks, Deputy County Surveyor, May the 17th 1881. Survey made by request of A. J. Montgomery and consent of all interested. Mrs. Walls and A. H. Bolz - chairmen - Sworn.

Corner No. 9. An Iron rod 1 in. in diameter and 18 1/2 ins. long Corner on the Range line 29.03 chains N. of the S. E. corner of Sec.

Corner No. 10. An Iron rod 1 in. in dia. at bottom & 1 in sq. at the top - 14 long from which ^{Sugar Sugar} 3. N. 19 W. 109 chns.

Corner No. 11. An Iron rod 1 1/2 in - 60 ft. west of corner No. 12. from which a Sugar 3. N 14 W. 107 chns.

Corner No. 12. An Iron rod 1 7/8 x 1 1/4 in. from which a Silver Poplar 18 5/8 x 1 1/2 in. 95 ft.

Corner No. 10. Set at N. E. Corner of Chas. Herbert's lot and at south side of Main St. in City of Brazil. Corner No. 11. at N. W. corner of the same lot. Corner No. 12. at S. W. Corner of Rebecca A. Thomas's Addition to the City of Brazil
