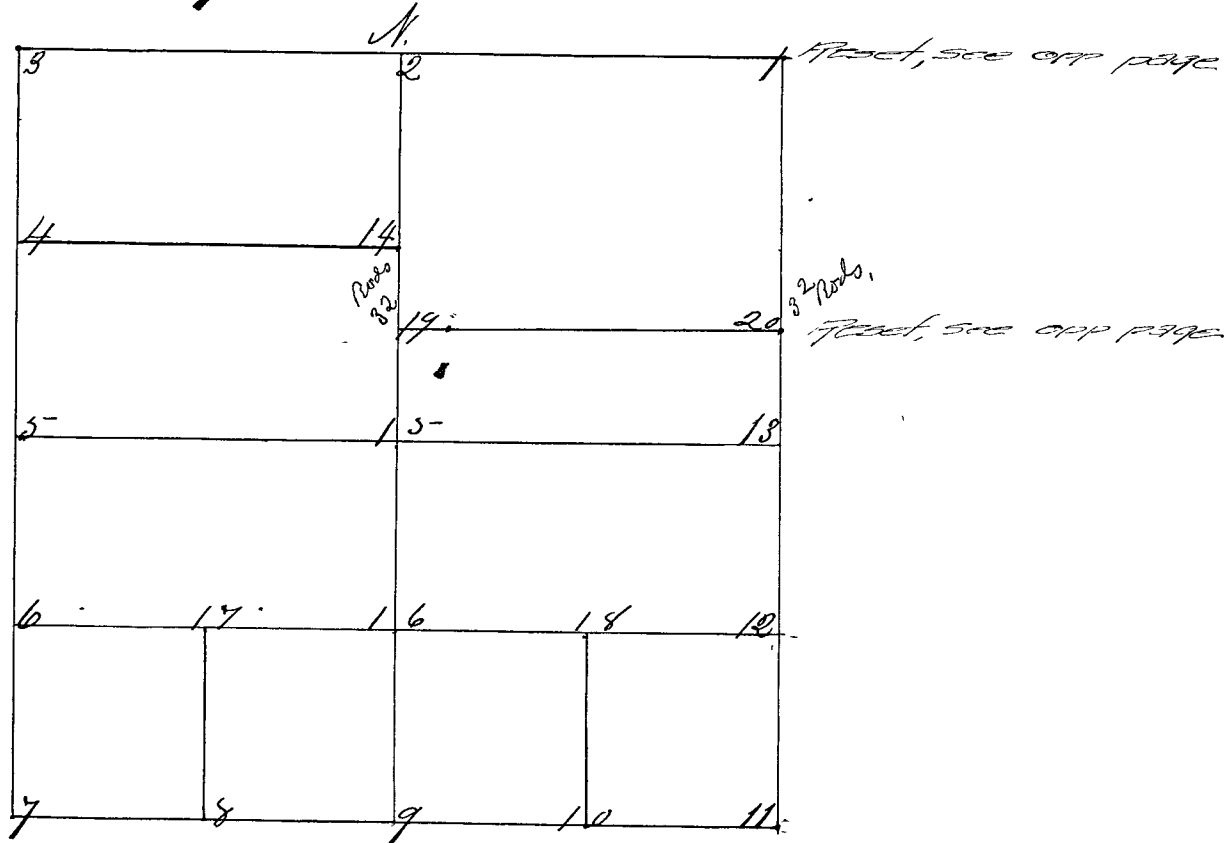


SECTION *Thirtythree* '33', TOWNSHIP *Ten* '10.'
